



Paul Steve Arnopoulos

November 14, 1932 - October 21, 2020

Arnopoulos, Pastor Paul Steve Age 87 of Mpls. passed away on October 21, 2020. He founded Disciples Ministry Church AKA Pastor Paul's Mission located in the historic Mikro Kodesh synagogue that he renovated in 1979. Realizing his North Mpls. neighbors needed food he started what became the largest independent free food distributor in the nation directly serving fresh and frozen food to over 18,000 registered households in Minnesota from 1980-2012. His ministry was started by his passion for the Gospel of Jesus. He was a faithful servant until the end. He was preceded in death by his parents, sister, and grandson. He is survived by his wife, Jeanine; brother, Dave Arno; sister, Connie Arnopoulos; daughters, Debborah (Eliot) Schaeffer, Sheryl Andersen, Julie (John) Gleason, Jade Durand; son, Steve Arnopoulos; 13 grandchildren; 8 great-grandchildren, other relatives and many friends. Due to COVID restrictions a private family graveside service was held at Fort Snelling National Cemetery where he received Military Honors for serving his country in the Airforce from 1950-1952.
