### Paul Myers Obituary

The memorial service celebrating the life of Paul Myers of Champlin MN will be held at 11:00 on the 13th of July, 2022 at Revive Church, Brooklyn Park, MN.

The world welcomed Paul David Myers on August 27th 1955 and the world became a little brighter. Paul lived a full life filled with kindnesses shown to others. Paul will be fondly remembered and sorely missed. He passed away unexpectedly at Mercy Hospital in Coon Rapids, MN on June 29th 2022. His wife Christine was with him at the time.

Paul was born in Mora, MN to Francis and Leona (Virnig) Myers. His dad gave him his first haircut. When he was a small child, the family moved to Elkhorn, WI. Paul was confirmed at St. Patrick's Church in May 1966. After graduating in 1973 from Elkhorn Area High School he attended Gateway Technical Institute in Racine, WI and was accepted for a Tool and Die Apprenticeship Program. Paul worked at Peerless Chain Company in Winona MN and received his Journeyman's certificate in 1979. On Nov. 8th 1978 he married Christine DeZeeuw and they lived in Winona, later moving to Texas from 1981 through 1994, and then to the present home in Champlin, MN.

Paul was a very creative and talented person with a keen mind for things that were mechanical or engineering in nature. Many people have said he could make anything. In his spare-time he pursued various craft and artistic interests including intricate cross stitch designs and sewed several quilts. He did wood and metal working projects for himself and others such as hand carved Santas and wood spirits; forged towel bars, knives and wall hooks. Building a 1964 GMC pickup truck has been a recent focus. Helping others made him happy and he was known for loving their rescue dogs, giving great hugs and telling jokes...

His professional career was diverse and largely related to production manufacturing: custom Tool and Die, wire forming production machine development and assembly, design drafting and manufacturing engineering. Some industries served were ice cream novelty production, industrial wood sanders, wire forming and silicon wafer handling. Paul also became an expert at trouble shooting and repairing household sewing machines.

Paul was preceded in death by his parents Francis and Leona (Virnig) Myers. He will be missed by his wife Christine, sisters Ramona (Byron) Mathews, Cindra (Kenneth) Vant, Leila (Steven) Shurts, Flora (Wes) Palmer, brother Lance, Christine's family, nieces and nephews, and a host of friends.
