Ralph Stanley Volkman, 91, born to Alma and Stanley Ralph Volkman in 1932, left his earthly body to be reunited with the love of his life, Betty Lou (Gothier) Volkman on August 13, 2024. Together they raised eight children in Columbia Heights: Cheryl (Scott) Knight, Alan Volkman, Stan (Lori) Volkman, Lynn (Jay) Kittelson, Joe (Mary) Volkman, Brian (Kris) Volkman, Therese Volkman, and Tom (Sande)

Volkman along with 15 grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren, and first great-great grandchild on the way.

Dad said the first day of homeroom in 10th grade, he saw Mom and knew she was the one he would marry. Upon graduation from Columbia Heights High School, they married and had celebrated their 68th anniversary the year Mom died in 2020. They were known for their love of each other, dancing, playing cards, golfing, and enjoying our 92-year-old family property on Ice Cracking Lake in northern Minnesota.

Ralph worked at the Columbia Heights Park Board before becoming the Superintendent of Fridley Public Works until retirement at the age of 60. He also proudly served 20 years as a Columbia Heights volunteer fireman and first responder, retiring as captain.

Since Mom died, Dad loved his time playing cribbage with his boy's, savoring

sweets, and spending time with family, friends, and his beloved dog Ruffles. His knowledge of Northeast Minneapolis and generational family history was extensive and was always willing to share. His sense of humor and his quick wit were going strong until his very last day. We will miss him dearly.
