After completing ROTC while at the University of Minnesota and serving in the Air Force during the Vietnam war, Rick earned his MBA, worked at the Federal Reserve in Minneapolis, and was the VP and CFO of Rosemount, Inc. for many years. Rick also served with high distinction in the Air Force reserves for 26 years, retiring as a full colonel, and was awarded the Legion of Merit.
