Dick was born in 1938 in Staples, Minnesota, to Alfred and Lydia Edin. He graduated from Staples High School and began his college education at Augsburg College in Minneapolis before transferring to and graduating from the University of Minnesota.

In 1960, Dick married Judie Tamte. The couple settled in Minneapolis before moving to Fridley, where they raised their family. Dick and Judie warmly welcomed anyone in need of a place to stay, always opening their home with generosity and kindness.

Dick spent the majority of his career as a Medical Products Engineer at 3M. Among his proudest achievements were his contributions to the development of the Littmann Stethoscope and Red Dot electrodes-innovations that left a lasting impact in the field of medical technology.

Following Judie's passing in 2002, Dick continued wintering in Naples and Bonita Springs, eventually becoming a full-time Florida resident. He had a passion for travel and was an avid outdoorsman who cherished time in nature.

Dick is survived by his daughter, Cheryl (David) Stibbe, his son, Rich Edin, and his beloved grandchildren, Hanna and Zach Stibbe. He was preceded in death by his wife Judie; brother Stanley; parents Alfred and Lydia; and dear friend Donna Bechik.
