They were married for 65 years when she passed in 2016. Dick worked for the Minneapolis Public Schools for over 30 years and retired in December of 1986. He worked part time at Oaks Hardware until dementia forced him to fully retire. Dick was a 50 year member of the Masons. Volunteering was a big part of his life starting with East Side Recreation while he was in college. One of his biggest accomplishments as a volunteer was in the role of President of the Marshall-University Policy Board where he represented the neighborhood in Washington D.C. and helped to secure funding for the merged school. Dick was a life long learner and kept himself busy with stained glass, cooking, work carving, gardening, and his grandchildren. Preceded in death by wife Zona, daughter Lisa Hugo, and grandson Sam Clough.
