Ovestrud Richard Mahlon Ovestrud, Jr., age 52, of Dublin, OH, died Monday, Dec. 16, 2002 at his home. He was an attorney with Allmerica Financial Co., Cleveland, OH, and formerly a managing attorney with Progressive Insurance. Previously, Richard was managing attorney with Hyatt Legal Services in Columbus. He was a member of the Ohio State, Nebraska and Alaska Bar Associations; was admitted to practice before the Ohio Supreme Court and a well-respected attorney among his peers.
