Robert "Rob" Barrett

Died unexpectedly on the 11th of October at his home in Chanhassen MN at the age of 51 years young. Robert is survived by his parents Dave and Jule Barrett, his wife Lynnette Barrett, sons Raymond and Adam Murillo, daughter in-law Run Murillo and granddaughter Lilliana. Robert was born on the 8th of March 1968, in Minneapolis, MN to Dave and Jule Barrett and graduated from Cambridge High School in 1986. He married the love of his life Lynnette on September 12th, 1998; the two enjoyed 21 years of marriage together.

Robert started his career as a collections agent with CPC in Eden Prairie in August of 2002, where he worked as one of five employees. With his tremendous work ethic and dedication to his team he became President of CPC in 2016 which now employs over 120 people; being an integral part of the company's growth.

Robert was an accomplished hunter and fisherman who won bass fishing tournaments held on several of the state of MN's 10,000 lakes. Robert was a generous and dedicated man who was passionate about mentoring others. He was an active and committed member of youth outreach programs including the Treehouse fishing day, D.A.R.E fishing tournaments and most recently coached the Elk River high school fishing team on the Student Angler Tournament Trail. Robert also had a fondness of firearms and was avidly pursuing a Gunsmithing Licensure prior to his passing.

Robert was a loving, caring, and devoted husband, son and brother that will be deeply missed by his family and friends. Robert's children remember him as a father that loved, supported and guided them through their lives.

A service is scheduled for Friday October 25th, 2019 at Pax Christi Catholic Community 12100 Pioneer Trail Eden Prairie, MN 55347. Visitation will be at 10 am and mass will be held at 11 am. There will be a celebration of life held at Buca di Beppo 7711 Mitchell Road Eden Prairie 55344 after the service all are welcome. “ To the family of Rob Barrett, we are all sorry to hear the sad news of Rob's passing. We are all praying for your family. I can't think of anyone else that I know that has had such a large impact on people in family, friends, and a business. He treated you as family. But it was never about him, it was, "How are you doing? How is your family?" He always put others first. If you ever had a bad day, he would always find a way to put a positive spin on it. He was the greatest story teller. If you think you were going to have a quick 5 minute conversation about something, it turned into 45 minutes, always entertaining!! By far the most generous person I have ever known. If we went somewhere, he drove. If we went out to dinner, he wouldn't let you buy.

When we finished our basement, he helped with the bathroom, I didn't ask, he offered. When my dad passed away, he was there to listen. Every holiday, he sent me a text message saying Happy Thanksgiving or Merry Christmas. When I brought my wife to the hospital this last December to have our baby, Rob called me 30 minutes after the birth of our son. "Is everything alright? Is Molly okay? How's the baby?"

I just stop and think of the impact Rob has had on me and family over the years, and I'm just one of many people he has impacted. My favorite memory is traveling to Dallas with him for work for a week. You really get to know someone being in a car for 28 hours. He said, "We are not stopping to eat a candle light dinner, we are stopping for gas, pop, and to pee, that's it". He meant every bit of it, 14 hours straight from the Twin Cities to Dallas.(I think we stopped 3 times)

We went into a toll booth and the car we were driving was low on gas, 5 miles until empty. There was a senior citizen couple ahead of us in line talking to the toll booth officer taking their sweet time. Rob blew up, honking his horn, holding it down, while we watched the fuel light say 2 miles until empty. "Really? Seriously?", Rob just kept yelling. They finally move, we pay the toll and the car ran out of gas as we rolled up to the pump at the gas station. I laughed so hard that I cried.

To the Barrett family, our prayers are with you through the difficult

times ahead.

Rob, you will be greatly missed. Life will not be the same without you. We love you Rob.

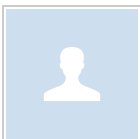
