Papas, Robert F. 73, of Minnetonka, passed away June 25, 2012. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Donita, and their four children: Susan Swann of Richfield, Jeff (Kris) of Cloquet, MN, Amy (Scott) Lussier of St. Louis Park and Jennifer of Hopkins; his brother, Al "Skip" Papas Jr. of Mpls, and five grandchildren. Bob served as Grand Master of Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons of Minnesota in 1990 and was a 33rd Degree Inspector General (Honorary) in the Minneapolis Valley of the Scottish Rite. He was a member of numerous other Masonic organizations and served as International President of the International Association of Printing House Craftsmen in 1984. He was a 40-year member of Oak Knoll Lutheran Church in Minnetonka. Bob was a Graphic Arts instructor at Minneapolis Southwest High School from 1961-72 before moving to what is now Hennepin Technical College. He retired as Director of Secondary Education there in 1995. Visitation is Thursday, June 28 from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. at Washburn-McReavy Edina Chapel, 5000 W. 50th St. & Hwy 100, with Masonic rites to follow.
