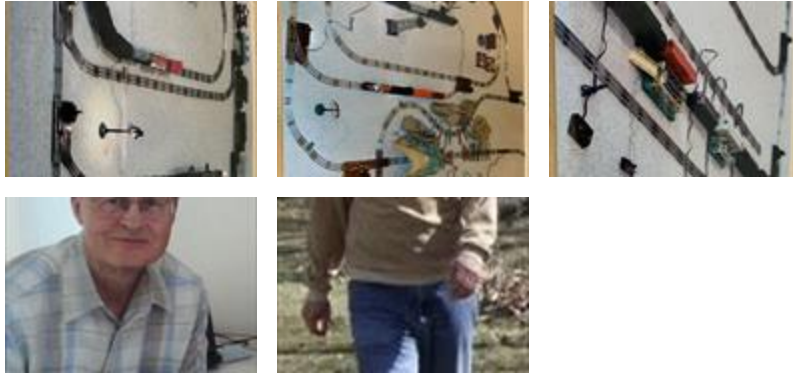

“ Bob and I met when we were toddlers. Our fathers lived in Milwaukee 5 blocks apart. They went to school together and remained good friends throughout their lives. In 1957, my parents moved 15 miles north to Mequon. Bob's parents moved one year later to the same subdivision. Bob and I have remained friends all these years. This last week, I've thought of our past times together. It's hard to think of any one memory over the span of 76 years. This is one I hadn't thought about in over 50 years. It took place in Virmond Park. In the mid-sixties, Bob and I used to go smelting in Lake Michigan using a seine net. It required us to wear waders, since the Smelt run starts in late March and runs into April. When we arrived at the Park, we took off our shoes and put on the waders. We proceeded to the Lake navigating a bluff that had no stairs and no pathways. While smelting, a wave washed over my waders and I had to take them off and call it a night. Here I am in wet socks and no way to get back to the car. The top of the bluff was about a 100 feet above the lake; it was steep and had a lot of thorny brush. Bob didn't hesitate, he hunched over and told me to get on his back and carried me up that entire bluff. At the time, I probably weighed 30 pounds more than him. I can't help but think of Dione Warwick's song "That's what friends are for" with tears in my eyes.
