Wiggins, Roberta "Bobbie" Age 79, of Eagan, passed away at home on New Year's Eve loved by Jim, her best friend and husband of nearly 60 years, her five children, eight grandchildren, a close extended family and large circle of friends. Bobbie was born in Saskatchewan but moved to Minneapolis as a child. Her sharp mind and big heart led into work with Children's Home Society of Minnesota where she helped set up or manage international adoption programs in Korea, India, Latin America, China, Romania, Vietnam, Bulgaria and Russia. She and Jim helped establish PACT, (Partners Aiding Children Today), a program to provide heart surgery in Minnesota for Vietnamese children; PATH (Parent's Association of Treatment Homes.) to provide foster care for children with challenging needs. They themselves provided foster care for 19 children. Her travel for fun and good works brought her on over fifty trips to places around the world.
