Harmon, Roger Rockwell Age 92 of Hopkins formerly of Edina passed away on July 4, 2023 after battling Parkinson's Disease. Born in Milwaukee, WI to Glenn and Hertha Harmon. The family moved to Minneapolis in 1944 where Roger later attended Washburn High School and graduated from the U of M with a BA in Journalism. He served with the Minnesota Army National Guard stationed in Alabama during the Korean War. His career was in Advertising and Sales starting at Scott-Atwater outboard motors. In 1968, he landed a job with World Toy House as a buyer of toys. He later became an independent sales rep for various toy manufacturers, selling items such as UNO card games, Hula hoops, Whiffle Ball, and Breyer horses for over 35 years. Roger travelled extensively for business and pleasure. His travels included trips to Hong Kong, Spain, Bahamas, Hawaii and his beloved Cayman Islands. Besides travel, Roger had numerous key interests including racquetball, tomato gardening and horse racing, spending many weekends at Canterbury Park.
