



## Roger John Koll

May 26, 1949 - January 30, 2026

Roger John Koll, age 76, of Bloomington, Minnesota, passed away on January 30, 2026, at the Minnesota Masonic Home in Bloomington after a courageous battle with Parkinson's disease and dementia.

Roger was born on May 26, 1949, in Minneapolis, Minnesota, to John and Florence Koll.

He attended the University of Minnesota, earning an associate degree in arts, and later continued his education at the Minneapolis Drafting School, where he received a diploma in architectural and structural drafting.

On June 30, 1979, he married Cynthia Mazorol, and together they lovingly raised three children: Kelly Marie, Gwynne Ann, and Daniel Roger.

Roger built a long and respected career as a construction manager, ultimately retiring from Nationwide Fixture Installations.

Music was one of Roger's greatest passions. He was a member of the band The Sandstones, where he played bass guitar and sang vocals. Even in his final moments, familiar melodies sparked a reflexive response-singing along or gently strumming in time. Those who knew Roger often remarked on his gracious spirit, his generous heart, and the warmth he showed through his

kind words and supportive presence. He was a man of steadfast faith whose gentle spirit and kindness touched everyone who knew him.

Roger is survived by his wife, Cynthia; his children, Kelly (Greg) Wineberg, Gwynne (Dusty) Chase, and Daniel; his grandchildren, Brielle, Ransley, Laikynn, and Dylan; and his sister, Diane (Koll) Sullivan.

He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Florence Koll, and his brother, Larry Koll.
