He attended Minneapolis Public Schools until joining the US Navy. He is a Veteran of the U.S. Naval Air Force, U.S. Navy, from which he was honorably discharged in 1948. He delighted in his time spent in the service of our country. Rollie continued his education at Lasalle University. Rollie was truly one of the great and good people in the world. He exemplified the epitome of a grand noble gentleman. He was 'class' personified, with an elegance that was admirable! His strength of body and mind were immeasurable in scope. His promotion to Branch Manager afforded a tremendous opportunity to develop skills that prepared him for the future. At age 33 Rollie left Spring Co. to form a partnership with R.A. White and W.C. Keefer, known as Skyline Builders, Inc. located on Central Avenue NE. Presently, Skyline Builders, Inc. Offices at 3647 McKinley Street NE, a multi-unit complex developed by Skyline. Health care became a focus in the middle 1960's and early 1970's and Skyline became one of the largest nursing home firms in the metro area with developing 700 plus beds, employing 600 people. With the death of R.A. White in 1971, Mr. Keefer and Mr. Stinski remained partners until Mr. Keefer's retirement in 1989.
