Boman, Ronald LeRoy Harold aged 86, entered the kingdom of heaven on November 2nd, 2024 surrounded by his loving family. Starting in July 2024 Ron suffered a series of medical issues shortly after the death of his beloved wife Margaret in May 2024.

Ron was born on 1/19/1938, in Minneapolis, MN, to Harold and Anna Boman. He was a resident of Maple Grove, MN. He grew up in Crystal, MN and was a 1956 graduate of Robbinsdale High School. Ron started out in the typewriter repair business owning his own business for 20 years. Ron was a dedicated member of the Brooklyn Center Fire Department for over 39 years with 31 of those being chief. He was the first full time chief for the city. He was instrumental in the creation of the Fire Dept. High Level Rope Rescue Team, the first Dive Rescue Team in the North Suburban Regional Mutual Aid Pact. And was active in the creation of the joint powers fire training center in Fridley. He was unanimously elected to honorary membership in Fire Instructors Association of Minnesota due to his commitment to education and Training for the fire service. He also taught fire courses at Hennepin Technical College.

Ron enjoyed snowmobiling, hunting, riding his motorcycle and traveling throughout the US and Internationally. He also enjoyed spending time with his

family. Ron was active in his church with various groups, a member of the Gideons and volunteered for Bibles for Missions. Dad and Margaret loved to serve the Lord together in any way they could.

Ron is preceded in death by his beloved wife Margaret, parents Anna and Harold Boman, his sister Lois (Calvin) Nelson, brother-in-law Marvin Masterman, and nephew Darren Boman.
