



Rory Travis Scott

June 27, 1959 - February 11, 2024

Rory Travis Scott, 64, died Sunday, Feb. 11, 2024 at Ridges Hospital, Burnsville, MN of a suspected pulmonary embolism with family present, leaving many family and friends to mourn.

Rory was born June 27, 1959 in Fremont, OH the son of Phyllis (Linkey) and Chandler Scott. Phyllis, widowed while Rory was in the womb, remarried Larry Bengry, and together Phyllis and Larry raised Rory as his mother and father. He attended schools in Bloomington, MN and was a graduate of Lincoln High School. He received his associate's degree from Normandale Community College and was trained as a police officer. Rory served in the United States Air Force as a security specialist, stationed in Germany and Montana.

While raising his family in Bloomington MN, he worked as a security guard, a school bus driver, and a technical draftsman. Most recently, he was an operations manager for Mrs. Stewart's Bluing, where he was still employed at the time of his death. He was active in Oak Grove Presbyterian Church as a youth group volunteer and a deacon. He loved nature and enjoyed hunting and fishing. He cherished his family, friends, and extended community. He enjoyed attending his grandchildren's sports and performances, going to plays and traveling with his wife, and playing Dungeons and Dragons with his son and friends. He was married to Nancy (Goolsby) Scott for 41 years.

Rory was preceded in death by his birth father, Chandler Scott; his dad, Larry Bengry; and brother, Rourk Scott. He is survived by his wife, Nancy; three children, Jac Nelson, Travis Scott, and Kaitlin (Jake) Krentz; mother, Phyllis Bengry; grandchildren, Harper Krentz, Amelia Krentz, Aiden Krentz and Wyatt Krentz; and sister, Pamela (Craig) Davidson.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, March 23, at 11 AM at Oak Grove Presbyterian Church in Bloomington, MN. Visitation one hour prior and a luncheon to follow. For those who cannot be there in person, the service will be live-streamed using the link provided:
