



## Rosita L. Ancheta

August 28, 1929 - November 14, 2018

Rosita Lumbo Ancheta, age 89, of Andover, Minnesota, passed away peacefully in her home on November 14, 2018, surrounded by her family. She was born to Bernardo and Timotea Lumbo in the Philippines on August 28, 1929. She attended Nursing School at the University of the Philippines, married Monico Soria Ancheta, and immigrated to the United States with her husband, son Alberto, and daughter Jocelyn in November 1966. Youngest son, Stanley, was born in September 1968. Rosita worked as a Registered Nurse at Fairview University and Mercy Hospital in Coon Rapids, retiring in 1991. She stayed active with the local Filipino community through the Cultural Society of Filipino Americans (CSFA), was an active angler, and took great pride in her many gardens, selling vegetables during summer and fall farmers markets. Rosita and Monico were also active members at St. Stephens Catholic Church in Anoka, MN. serving as members of the Monday church cleaning crew in later years. Rosita is survived by her husband of 63 years, Monico, sons Alberto (Jennifer) and Stanley (Brenda), and daughters Jocelyn (Joe) and Rufina (Gary). Grandmother to Erin (Caleb), Gavin, Stanley, Grant, Angelo and Chrisly. Mass of Christian Burial will be Tuesday, November 20th, 11 a.m. with visitation one hour prior at St. Stephen's Catholic Church, 525 Jackson St., Anoka. Internment at Calvary Cemetery.

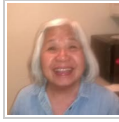

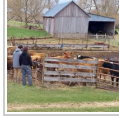

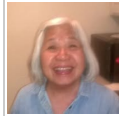
