Roy William Struble was born on January 13, 1928 in St. Paul, Minnesota to parents Ernest and Velma Struble. Roy lived in St. Paul his whole life except for a short period of time in Oakland, California just before serving in World War II. Roy served two years in the Navy in Hawaii, shortly after the bombing of Pearl Harbor. He came back to St. Paul after the war and met up again with a young nurse named Melba Kvistad. She was "the girl across the street" and cousin to his lifelong best friend Duane Erickson. Roy and Melba got married in Minnesota on June 17, 1948.

Roy went to the University of Minnesota and Purdue University, he worked as a programmer, systems analyst and consultant in the burgeoning computer industry.

He finished his career as a systems analyst with the city of St. Paul.

Roy is survived by his wife of 74 years Melba Struble.
