Ruby Winnifred Ohman was born January 23, 1930 to Albert and Esther Johnson in Pine City, Minnesota. Ruby was the second youngest of 5 siblings - Lester, Florence, Eunice, Gladys, and Frances Johnson. She gave her life to Jesus Christ at 11 years of age, and was baptized at Forest Lake Church of Christ. Ruby graduated from Forest Lake High School in 1948, then got her LPN from Miller Hospital School of Practical Nursing in 1949. Her 20 years of nursing were at Miller, Abbott and Abbott Northwestern Hospitals, as well as various nursing homes. She then shifted to using her gift of cooking and baking through catering at St Joseph's Home for Boys, The University Women's Club, as well as for many weddings and events. Ruby was an exacting baker, talented seamstress, and always had a sharp sense of humor. She enjoyed reading her Bible, praying for others, and writing letters to friends and family.

Ruby was a longtime member of Bethlehem Baptist Church in Minneapolis.
