



Sally Frances Boedeker

March 26, 1935 - October 29, 2024

Sally Frances Boedeker (Green) died after a short illness on October 29, with loved ones by her side in Minneapolis.

Born March 26, 1935, in Omaha, NE to Thomas and Anne (Tierney) Green, she attended Duchesne Academy and Creighton University, earning a BS in Nursing in 1957. Moving to Minneapolis with friends after graduation, she rose to become a head nurse on the obstetrics ward at St. Mary's Hospital. Sally married US Navy veteran Charles Owen Boedeker on Dec 26, 1964, and they began a family. William (Bill) and Frederick Scott were born in Minneapolis before the family moved to De Pere, WI where "Chuck" worked as an engineer at Healy Mechanical Contractors. Their children Sheila, Thomas, and Mary Ann soon arrived.

After the death of Charles in 1977, Sally returned to obstetric nursing, working at Bellin Memorial Hospital in Green Bay while earning a Master's in Nursing from UW-Oshkosh in night classes. She taught at Bellin College of Nursing until her retirement in 2003.

Sally is survived by sons, Bill (New York) and Scott (Minneapolis), and daughters, Sheila (Mike, Henderson, MN) and Mary Ann (Adam, Roseville, MN), and extended family. Charles and Sally were preceded in death by their infant son, Thomas.
