She survived four years of the Killing Fields of Cambodia and two years of refugee camps to become a successful business owner, wife and mother in the US. Preceded in death by her parents, brothers, sisters, nieces, nephews and daughter, Baby Girl. She is survived by husband Eang; son Cheng (Le); daughter Rachel (Henry); sister Emily; brother Hoa; grandchildren Jen, Min, Mila and Keith; nieces; nephews and many friends. Memorial service will be held at Swanson Chapel (1600 Lowry Avenue N. Minneapolis, MN 55411) on Saturday, April 29. Visitation will be one hour starting at 8:30am, followed by service, and then vegetarian lunch reception at U Garden (2725 University Ave SE, Minneapolis, MN 55414) at 12 noon.
