Scott loved to laugh while folding clothes, doing dishes, putting supplies away, making meals, chocolate cake, cheesecake, chocolate shakes, Dairy Queens, McDonalds, Big R, going on the bread run at CIP, shopping at CUB, Byerly's, Coborns & Festival, swimming at the Y, watching The Food Channel, Wheel of Fortune, Church on Sunday with Communion & Offering, taking dog treats to Trooper, Dunn Bros, Caribou & Starbucks, going to work at CIP, going to the movies, getting mail, saying Grace, and he loved his friends, family and Jesus. Scott's Celebration Party will be held at 10:00 on Saturday morning, 5 April 2008 at Zion Lutheran Church in Anoka.
