September 21, 1945 - November 6, 2022

Sharon (Abbott) Dack died on November 6, 2022 at the Sholom Home West Nursing facility in St. Louis Park, Minnesota after a long battle with Parkinson's disease. Sharon did not spend her life at home. After her boys were school-age, she worked for multiple banking institutions as a receptionist including Wells Fargo in downtown Minneapolis. After a long career, she retired and enjoyed a pleasant retirement. Sharon is survived by her husband, two sons, and 4 grandchildren. She is also survived by a brother, Gerald Abbott in Austin, Texas. She was preceded in death by her brothers, David Abbott and Dale Abbott.
