Shi-Di Cheng was born on December 15, 1961 to Yushan Cheng and Jintao Liu in Taipei, Taiwan, ROC. She grew up and attended Taipei Municipal Jinhua Junior High School, Taipei First Girls High School, and with the Class of 1984 from National Central University with major in Physics. In January 1987, she went to Iowa City to attend master's program in University of Iowa. She earned her first master's degree with high remarks. Later she started study in electrical engineering in Iowa State University. She held both master's and Ph.D. degrees from ISU.

Shi-Di started her first professional job in August 1998 with Seagate Technology in Bloomington, Minnesota. She held the title of Senior Staff Engineer as of January 2021. On June 23, 1987, Shi-Di was united in marriage to Pin Chung in Iowa City, Iowa. On June 19, 1988, they hosted a wedding ceremony in Taipei. Shi-Di enjoyed music, food, Chinese opera, and traveling. She also loved studying the Bible, discussed current political events.

Shi-Di and Pin were baptized on May 20, 2018 in Taipei to become reborn Christians.

Shi-Di was diagnosed with ovarian cancer on November 2nd, 2017. She had treatments for over three years. Shi-Di passed away peacefully in the

University of Minnesota Medical Center on January 19, 2021 at the age of 59 years old. Shi-Di will be dearly missed by her family and friends. Shi-Di is survived by her husband, Pin Chung; parents: Yushan Cheng, Jintao Liu; brother Tony Cheng, and sister Jenny Cheng.
