



## Shirley Pearl Hill

December 31, 1926 - August 23, 2021

Hill, Shirley Pearl, 94 of Minneapolis, died August 23, 2021. Born in St. Paul on December 31, 1926 to Edward and Betty Fink, she graduated from Minneapolis North High School in 1944 and was valedictorian of her Hebrew class at Talmud Torah. She was the first in her family to graduate college from the University of Minnesota in 1948 as a Medical Technologist, a profession which introduced her to her husband Dr. Earl Hill who she married in 1948. She was a proud devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. Shirley was the sunshine in every room with her radiant smile.
