Our dearly loved Shirley Seid (Pickett) passed away peacefully at the age of 95 on July 10th, 2025.

She loved her daughter unconditionally and they had a special bond. She was a wonderful

mother teaching Sue valuable lessons about kindness, strength, courage and love. She married Larry Seid who passed away in 1979. Shirley was a proud member of the Brooklyn Park Lady Lions for 62 years working tirelessly to help others who were less fortunate. She also was a member of the Legion and Eagles Club. Shirley loved spending times with friends who she traveled with and shared many good times and adventures.
