Signe Sadie Adeline (Strande) Hearst was born in Clear Lake, SD on Sept 21, 1924. She attended St. Cloud Teacher's College. She enlisted in the US Women's Army Corp in 1943, serving in several army hospitals in the states, attending soldiers returning with shell shock. She became a lab technician and was discharged in 1946 with the rank of E5 Staff Sergeant. She met Jay Hearst who was a 2nd Lieutenant in the Army Air Corp who helped her attain a pilot's license. After the war they were married. She was a very successful businesswomen who owned two health food stores. Sig led a very interesting life and was a very generous and kind human soul. She helped many people and never judged, but accepted who you were.
