Stan was born January 1, 1929 on a farm by Mankato, MN. As a youngster he had to work many outside jobs to help his family as they struggled through The Great Depression. In high school he was All State in football and All Conference in basketball. Stan received a scholarship offer from Notre Dame, but opted not to attend due to financial concerns. He was the only one in his family to receive a college degree and he also obtained a Master's degree. He served in the National Guard and was drafted during the Korean War.

Stan met Elizabeth Eischens at a dance. She said, "No" the first two times he asked her to dance but on the third she said, "Yes!" They were married 72 years and raised six sons. They have 14 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren. Stan spent most of his years teaching at Golden Valley High School where he was also the head wrestling and cross country coach. Stan loved playing cards, sports, travel, cracking jokes and eating Hostess Twinkies.
