Stanley Andrew Symanski, age 90, passed away on December 11, 2025. He was born on September 16, 1935, in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin.

In his mid-20s, he moved to Northeast Minneapolis with his mother, Pauline, where they lived together until her passing in 2001.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Edmund and Pauline, and his brother Tom, who passed away in August 2024. He is survived by his sisters Theresa, Elizabeth and Sylvia, along with many nieces, nephews, great-nieces and nephews, and great-great-nieces and nephews.

He dedicated more than 44 years to Metal Matic, where he specialized in setting up machines to run miles of tubing. built-in family reunion. He attended church faithfully every weekend and cherished hearing stories about the lives of those he loved. A humble man, he will be remembered for his devotion to family and his quiet strength.
