Stephen "Steve" K. Seidl passed away peacefully at his home on November 23, 2025.

Born in Minneapolis, MN to Joseph and Viola (Olson) Seidl, Steve attended St. Charles Borromeo School and graduated from St. Thomas Academy in 1968. He earned his degree from the University of Minnesota in 1972. In 1969, Steve proudly joined the United States Marine Corps, where he was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant. Over a distinguished military career, he rose to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel and served as a senior watch officer with Marine Forces Pacific, retiring in 2000.

Following his military service, Steve dedicated 35 years to a successful career in real estate with Coldwell Banker. Upon retirement, he devoted his time to volunteering with various organizations and embraced his love of the outdoors as an avid fisherman and hunter.

Steve was preceded in death by his parents, Joseph and Viola, and his brother Joseph.
