Stroh, Stephen Benedict Age 47, of Plymouth passed away August 25 after a 4 ½ year battle with Multiple Myeloma. Steve was a 25 year veteran of the Edina Police Department, achieving the rank of sergeant. Police work was his true calling, and he enjoyed and continued to work throughout his illness, up to the week before his death. Steve was preceded in death by grandparents Stephen and Anne Malone and Casper and Magdalena Stroh, uncles Martin and Alfred Stroh, aunts Eleanor Lehn and Eugenia Kuhn and cousins Donald and Mark Stroh. He is survived by his parents Ben and Kathleen Stroh of Edina; wife Caroline and daughter Shannon; sister Anne Oswald (Brent) of Plymouth; brother John (Shannon) of Eden Prairie; nieces and nephews: Henry, Emily, and Ryan Oswald, Grace and Molly Stroh; mother-in-law Carroll Cochrane Cisek; many aunts, uncles and cousins. He is also survived by many friends, and his work family at the City of Edina. Steve and his wife were members of the Benilde-St. Margaret's High School Class of 1983. He graduated from St. Thomas College with a degree in criminal justice in 1987, and completed the Alexandria Technical College police skills program in August of 1987. He became a sworn peace officer in October of 1987. He received his Masters of Police Administration from the University of St. Thomas in 2005.
