Zima, Stephen Milan age 94, went home to his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He began his journey on June 17th, 2022. Preceding him in death are his parents, Rev. Stephen Zima and Anna Kerestes, and his sister, Anna Ludmila Lovseth, also, his 1st wife of 26 years, Naida Corrine Zima.
