As an engineer with The Boeing Company, Steve worked on NASA's Apollo 11/Saturn V Project, for which he was awarded the Apollo/Saturn V Roll of Honor. He also spent many years working as a defense engineer with Honeywell/Alliant Techsystems. Steve married Carmen Chin in New Orleans, Louisiana in 1965. They have two children, Michael (Cindy) Moy and Angela (Joel) Luedtke and four grandchildren: Molly Moy, Mason Luedtke, Joshua Luedtke and Maya Moy. Steve was his grandchildren's biggest fan and could always be spotted at their concerts, sporting events and Sunday School programs. Steve and Carmen traveled to most of the countries in every continent except Antarctica. He served as an elder and a deacon at Faith Church.
