Throughout her life, she volunteered for many non-profits and church organizations. Sufia loved relaxing with a hot cup of tea, and she leaves her dreams of having a house of tea café for her family. Having hosted several art exhibits, Sufia's artwork was spontaneous and insightful. You could always find paint and canvas around her. Her love for beauty was also found in her constant care of her garden of flowers and

vegetables. Sufia spoke her mind plainly, and her singing and smile lit up a room. Her joy spilled out in songs at the crack of dawn, as her children can attest, and in her younger years, she was rumored to burn up the dance floor with her fancy moves.

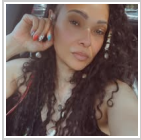
