



Terence Joseph Hogan

November 5, 1937 - January 24, 2026

Terence Hogan, age 88, passed away calmly at home on January 24, 2026. Born in Calgary, Alberta, to John and Winifred Hogan, Terry was preceded in death by his parents, wife of 52 years, Susan, brother and sister-in-law John and Elizabeth Hogan, and brothers-in-law Paul and Stephen Youngdahl. He is survived by his children, Trent, Kyle, and Jill (Bo), granddaughters, Meredith and Eliza Dunlap, sisters-in-law, Nancy and Phyllis Youngdahl, seven treasured nephews, and his favorite niece. A proud graduate of Western High School in Calgary, Terry attended college in Fullerton, California, before joining the U.S. Army, where he achieved the rank of Sergeant. As a Lifetime Member of the PGA, he dedicated 24 memorable years as the Head Golf Professional at the Town and Country Club of St. Paul. Terry was particularly proud of the club's caddy program, where he mentored hundreds of young people, several of whom became Evans Scholars. Whether emceeing or auctioneering, he was a gentleman in every space he entered. Simple things gave him joy, like planning cross-country road trips for his family or tending bar as he and Susan hosted one of their signature dinner parties. The roles Terry cherished most were those of husband to Susan, father to Trent, Kyle, and Jill, father-in-law to Bo, and Daddo to Meredith and Eliza. Terry was one of the "Old Pros" in golf and in life.

A service of remembrance will be held on March 12, 2026, at 11 a.m., with a visitation at 10 a.m., and a reception to follow the service at Mount Olivet
