



Terrance Robert Dolan

April 17, 1961 - March 29, 2025

Dolan, Terrance Robert Age 63 of Edina passed away on March 29, 2025. Terry Dolan, son of Joseph and Evelyn Dolan, was born April 17, 1961 in Milroy, Minnesota as the tenth of 13 children. He grew up knowing the value of hard work and was part of an active, busy farm family. He was very proud of his Irish Catholic family.

As one of 20 high school graduates in 1979, Terry was deeply involved in sports and activities, including theater, band, football, basketball, baseball, cross-country and track. In the summers, he practiced golf at the Tracy Country Club where he took note of a cute girl golfing ahead of him. True to his shy nature, after nine months, he finally worked up the courage to give her a call.

Terry attended college at the University of St. Thomas, majored in accounting, and married Susan Mix - that cute golfing girl - in 1982. He started his career in public accounting and eventually specialized in banking. They were blessed with two daughters and moved to Ohio.

In 1998, an offer to join U.S. Bank brought him back to Minnesota. Terry served as Controller before later becoming Chief Financial Officer and then Vice Chair and Chief Administration Officer. A tireless worker, he had a unique ability to lead, inspire and problem solve; Terry made everyone feel

comfortable with his authenticity and gentle humor. He loved to travel and experience new cultures and places.

Terry loved telling stories with family. Annually, he sang rousing renditions of Irish folk songs at the Dolan Family Classic, a golf tournament. If he had a few extra hours on a Saturday, you could find Terry at the local hardware store, roaming up and down the aisles. He loved to tinker and applied his skills up north at the family lake cabin, where he created many special memories with his children, grandchildren and extended family.

Terry was an active philanthropist who believed in supporting local communities. He served on the board of directors for the Killebrew Thompson Memorial and cultural institutes like the Minnesota Opera, Artspace and the Cowles Center. Terry also served on the boards of Catholic Charities, the College of St. Benedict and the Minneapolis Foundation. He was honored with a street named after him, "Terry Dolan Drive," which celebrates his lasting impact revitalizing the Pullman Community in Chicago.

He is survived by Susan, his wife of 42 years; daughters Jane (Chris) and Hannah (Eric) and six beautiful grandchildren; siblings Kenny Dolan, Mike (Cela) Dolan, Larry (Linda) Dolan, Dan (Linda) Dolan, Tim Dolan, Jean (Donnie) Schmidt, Janette (Steve) LaVoy, Mary (Bob) Andersen, Patty Dolan, Neil (Linda) Dolan, Bob (Peggy) Dolan; brother-in-law Steve Oakland; and many nieces and nephews. Preceded in death by parents, sister Rose Oakland, sisters-in-law Marie Dolan, Joy Dolan and brother-in-law David Mann.

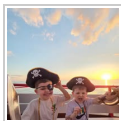

“ I originally posted this on Facebook:

I saw the news that a small plane had crashed into a house in Brooklyn Park, Minnesota - another anonymous tragedy. I was shocked and saddened to learn that the pilot of that crash was US Bank executive Terry Dolan. I have known Terry since we were accounting students at the College of St. Thomas (now the University of St. Thomas) in St. Paul, MN.

We met in Shirley Poleski's Intermediate Accounting class in the fall of 1980. This course represented a significant hurdle on the path to becoming an accounting major. If you couldn't pass this two-semester class, you wouldn't be able to graduate with an accounting degree; however, if you did pass, it would be smooth sailing after that.

Poleski was a force. She used to boast that she had given birth to her son on a Friday and was back to work by Monday. On the first day of class, she surveyed the classroom of about 40 of us and said, "Five of you will get a job with a Big-8 accounting firm - what the hell else are the rest of you going to do?" She then introduced us to former students who had not taken the Big-8 path to explain how they leveraged their accounting degrees. This was huge for me, as I was not Big-8 material.

I became aware of Terry during our first test. The test was difficult, and I didn't feel confident about it. A few days later, Poleski returned our tests, and there was a big red D at the top of mine. I glanced around at the other students, and all I saw was a sea of Ds and Fs. Poleski could read the room - the anxiety was palpable - and said, "Well, I suppose you all think this test must not be fair or that I am not a good teacher given the grades, but I want to tell you that I am a good teacher, and this is a fair test because Terry got an A!" Terry's reaction was neither embarrassment nor pride, but a humble, zen-like confidence.

It was at that moment that I decided to get to know Terry and, if possible, find a way to study with him. Fortunately, Terry was a generous guy who took me under his wing and helped me master Intermediate Accounting. We socialized a bit; I remember going on a double date with women who ultimately became our wives. We were not close friends; we were more like colleagues. Terry ended up with one of those Big-8 jobs, of course, while I worked for First Bank System. We lost touch.

Then, one day, Terry appeared on the audit team reviewing the bank, and we reconnected. He was clearly on the fast track at his firm but remained the same unpretentious guy I had known in college. Again, we lost contact.

We met again in Edina, where we had both moved. We attended the same Catholic parish, and our kids attended the same public schools. We frequently ran into each other. Terry was now at First Bank, while I had left First Bank for Farm Credit. He was on the fast track at First Bank as it transformed into U.S. Bank. Each time I encountered Terry, despite his rising success, he remained the same down-to-earth guy I had met in that Intermediate Accounting class.

You encounter people like Terry as you navigate life. They may not be your closest friends, but they have positively influenced your journey. I enjoyed a rewarding career in banking, and knowing Terry made me a better person and a better businessman. Rest in peace, Terry.
