



Thomas Alan Bonneville

Bonneville, Thomas Alan 81, of Edina, MN passed away peacefully on November 5, 2020. He was born on July 11, 1939 in Minneapolis, MN to William A. and Loretta (Meyer) Bonneville, and was raised in Bismarck, ND, where he graduated from Bismarck High School. He attended the University of North Dakota, where he was a member of Beta Theta Pi fraternity and the Varsity Bards. He received a B.S. Degree in Industrial Engineering and a B.S. Degree in Business Administration, and he received an Air Force ROTC Commission. Following graduation, he married his college sweetheart, Deanna M. Nelson, and was her loving husband for 58 years. They moved to Arizona, where he was stationed at Luke Air Force Base. After his honorable discharge from the Air Force, they moved to Minneapolis, MN, where he was employed at Control Data Corporation before beginning a 42-year career in property development with Dayton's, Dayton-Hudson Corporation and Target Corporation. He was a member of Mt. Olivet Lutheran Church for 56 years. Tom was known for his strong character, values, and morals that guided his strong work ethic and faith, and will be remembered as a man of integrity who did not waver from his Christian values and his family.
