Thomas Delano Harmon, age 84, of Minneapolis, MN, died peacefully on June 10, 2024.

Thomas was born on May 9, 1940 to Thomas and Alta Harmon in Minot, ND. He attended DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis. On October 1 of 1960, Tom married Sue Carlson at St. Peter's church in Richfield, MN. He graduated from Metro State University and later from Willam Mitchell College of law. He spent the latter part of his career practicing law after having worked 30+ years with Honeywell.

During his Honeywell years, he also spent evenings and weekends as a sports writer covering high school sports for the Sun Current and later authoring a book about his upbringing in the Catholic school system.
