



## Thomas Livdahl

June 29, 1940 - January 2, 2025

Thomas G. Livdahl, 84, of Bloomington, Minnesota, died peacefully at home on January 2, 2025. He was preceded in death by parents, Gilford and Dorothy Livdahl and survived by wife, Carol; daughter, Kristin; son, Steven, brother, David, and grandchildren, Alessandra and Tobias.

Tom was born on June 29, 1940, in Moorhead, Minnesota. He graduated from St. Paul Central High School in 1958. He attended Macalester College where he graduated in 1962 with a B.A. in Economics. He enlisted in the navy the same year and served as a supply officer on the USS Diamond Head. He married Carol Price on January 9, 1965, partway through his deployment and later had two children, Kristin and Steven. In 1972, he received an MBA from the University of Minnesota in 1972. He worked for Control Data, Ceridian and General Dynamics in a variety of positions including contract management and stockholder services throughout his career.

Tom was an active and involved dad and grandpa, coaching his kids' teams in the Bloomington Athletic Association, chaperoning school field trips and playing with his grandkids. He enjoyed time with friends and family at his cabin on Sand Lake near Cumberland, WI. He loved entertaining and had a large and close-knit group of friends and had many fun times with his bridge group, fishing openers and woodcutting and cabin weekends. He was an avid downhill, x-country and water skier. He played clarinet and saxophone in a

band named the Starlighters during high school and college. He was active for a number of years in the Macalester College alumni association, including serving as its president.

He will be remembered as a kind and devoted son, big brother, husband, dad, grandpa and friend.
