



## Thomas Anthony Zschokke

February 12, 1943 - February 20, 2018

Tom was born the seventh of eight children in St. Paul. He was a member of St. Bernard High School's first graduating class in 1961. After high school he entered the United States Marine Corp and served as a Sergeant in Vietnam.
