Marrinan, Timothy D. Age 72 of Edina, passed away January 29, 2018 while surrounded by his loving family. He was preceded in death by his parents, James and Shirley Marrinan; and sister, Teri Marrinan. Tim was a graduate of St. Thomas Military Academy, the University of Minnesota's undergraduate program and law school. He was a long-time compliance and banking law expert but his true passion was history. He served on the President's Counsel at Colonial Williamsburg for many years and taught students at Our Lady of Grace and St. Thomas Academy about the Revolutionary and Civil Wars. Tim served as a board member at the Henry Sheldon Museum in Middlebury, Vermont, where he and his wife Patti also resided. He served on the University of St. Thomas School of Law Organizational Ethics and Compliance Program Advisory Board, where he was instrumental in the Program's inception and development. Throughout his life, Tim supported the Phi Beta Kappa motto, "love of learning is the guide of life." Tim's family brought him the greatest amount of joy and we all benefited from his love and devotion. He blessed everyone he met while performing his roles as a punster and a one-stop shop for all things history, banking, and sports. Tim enjoyed daily morning mass at Our Lady of Grace followed by chats with his coffee klatch.
