Tim was born on 7/3/1943 in Moorhead MN. He grew up there and graduated from Moorhead high school. He married Peggy Lee Lange on 4/25/1964 and remained happily married until his death. He was in the US Army, stationed in Fort Monmouth NJ. Tim and Peggy lived in nearby Asbury Park, NJ. There they had their son Joel at Patterson Army hospital. Right after Joel was born Tim was sent to Vietnam where he spent about 10 months. After his discharge

from the Army, they moved back to Moorhead. They eventually made their home in St Louis Park, MN and had their daughter Jill. Throughout his career, Tim worked for White Motor Company, American Hoist and Derrick, ADC Telecommunications, and finally Mark Mullin Sales.

Tim was generous, fiercely loyal, passionate, stubborn, faith-filled, and loving. He loved Jesus, his wife and family, and enjoyed just about anyone he met. Tim was always willing to help out if anyone asked. He would share his faith with anyone who would listen to him. Tim enjoyed reading, fishing, traveling, and talking about his grandsons. He enjoyed going out to eat with friends, attending small group at church, delivering donated food from church to PRISM, delivering Meals on Wheels, and packing meals at Feed My Starving Children. Tim spent as much time as he could with his grandsons and was extremely proud of them. He attended every sporting event they participated in and every school performance they had. He volunteered at the boys school, Maranatha Christian Academy, usually greeting kids in the morning. He was affectionately know as Grandpa Tim at MCA and in local sport communities. Tim lived a great and fulfilled life, yet he left us too soon. We rejoice that he is healthy and whole in heaven and cannot wait to see him again.
