Timothy Luis Vincent passed away unexpectedly surrounded by family and close friends on Friday, July 29, 2022.

From the time he was 6 years old, he attended La Semana Day camp each summer where he could learn more about Colombia and be surrounded by other adopted children from Latin America. He learned traditional Colombian dances, eating Colombian food, music, etc. He liked traditional dancing, but loved salsa dancing. His aunt Mile said it "was in his genetics"! He attended

Robbinsdale Spanish Immersion Elementary School, where he learned to speak Spanish fluently. While attending Bethel University, he studied abroad in Spain. Recently, he moved to Cedar City, Utah where he was going to school to be a helicopter pilot. He once said his dream was to assist in helicopter rescue. He was always interested in helping people, which is why it was no surprise that he served in the Navy's Construction Battalion (C.B.'s) for five years. During that time, he lived in Mississippi and was deployed to Gabon, Micronesia, Spain, Djibouti, and Somalia. One of his favorite things he got to do while in the Navy was helping build schools and health clinics.

Throughout his life he was always up for a new adventure. His adventurous spirit led him to love snowboarding, hiking, and rock climbing. He was thinking of taking on his next endeavor of adopting a bernese mountain dog to be his companion on hikes. When he wasn't working, traveling, or in school, he enjoyed spending time with friends and family . . . he loved people. He learned to play the drums in middle school, and continued playing in spontaneous jam sessions with his buddies or as part of a praise and worship team in the Navy. He was very sensitive, goofy, serious, athletic, and intuitive. He hated injustice. Without him, our family will be missing a BIG piece of our family puzzle.

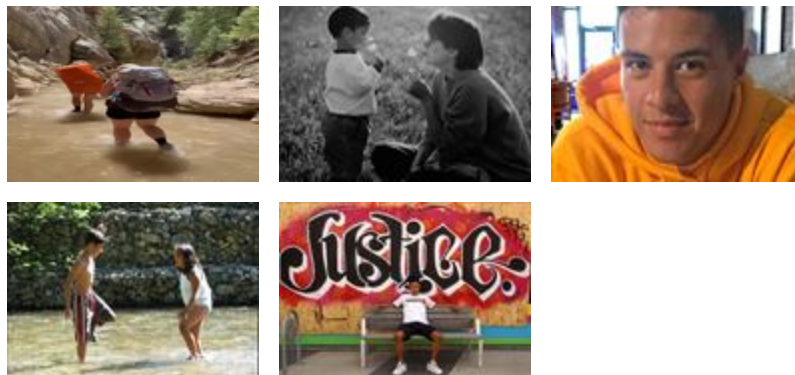
