Hull, Traverse "Cordell" Age 89, of Bloomington, passed away May 5, 2025. Born to Beatrice (Dale) and Traverse Hull in Milwaukee WI. Preceded in death by parents and sister Bev Manske.

In the 1950's, he began a lifelong career in office equipment sales and service with the AJ Farnum Co in Milwaukee leaving as Treasurer/Vice President in 1971 and moving to the Twin Cities to start his own company, Interstate Office Systems, with offices in Edina, Duluth and Lacrosse. During this time, he also served a term as president of the national Sony office products dealer organization. When he retired, he became a self-taught stock market investor and enjoyed the daily intrigue of buying and selling. Cordell was a diehard Vikings fan, never missing a game even in the cold of the old Met stadium. He also loved traveling, especially to escape MN winters-- St. Maarten, Mexico, and Sanibel were favorites. Trips to Japan for business, and to visit daughter Lori and Bob during their time in London were special times. Many summer memories were made at the cabin in WI and later at the family's resort in northern MN. He enjoyed the great outdoors, watching and photographing sunsets and wildlife (including those in his own backyard), and was an accomplished grill master. He was the life of the party, with a great sense of humor and unforgettable laugh. And he loved and spoiled his little fur babies - dogs and cats alike.
