“A Legacy for Trevor Marsh Belonging came naturally to Trevor. An athlete and long-time member of the South Metro Tigers Rugby Club in South Minneapolis, Trevor was known by his friends as a caring comrade, always ready to listen and help. After he became the victim of a senseless murder in 2006, his parents decided the best way to create a legacy for Trevor was to establish a fund in his name that would create a positive impact in the lives of young people. “After all of our research, we chose Madison Community Foundation as the home for the Trevor Marsh Memorial Fund,” said Bruce Marsh, Trevor’s father. “The staff was respectful and responsive to our needs, and their fee structure was the lowest of all the funds we researched.” Since 2007, distributions from the fund have helped support Trevor’s team, the South Metro Tigers Rugby Club, enabling them to double in size. The team serves a diverse group of inner city kids of all races, backgrounds and income levels, for whom the camaraderie of rugby provides a community focus and a sense of belonging. “When remembering Trevor, we would like to add joy to the lives of young people,” added Bruce Marsh. “Our goal is to inspire these teens by giving them an opportunity to try an activity that helps them gain self confidence and learn some life skills.
