While raising a growing family she worked at Crestview Nursing Home. After Veronica and Doyle became empty nesters, she went back to work refinishing

furniture.

Veronica was famous for her overnight rolls, chocolate chip cookies, potato salad, fried bread dough, Crisco pancakes and the longest good-bye, where Doyle waited impatiently for his bride to leave any family gathering. Veronica's happiness and great joys were her grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Veronica enjoyed researching genealogy for the Walters and Larkin families. She had a talent for making Christmas trees out of jewelry. Often Veronica put caring for family and friends before her own needs.

Veronica had the luck of the Irish. Could this be why she was struck by lightning on two separate occasions? She frequently won at the casino and pull-tabs and generously shared her winnings. Her sharp wit and salty attitude will be greatly missed by family and friends.

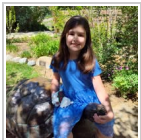
