It is with a broken heart and much sadness that I share that Vicki Hackett, age 57 of Robbinsdale MN, passed away at home in the early morning hours of Wednesday, December 10th, 2025 unexpectedly, suddenly and accidentally due to an unknown health issue at the time.

Vicki's last job was being an ESL teacher and she loved her students and seeing them succeed.

She battled Parkinson's Disease for the last 5 years of her life. It was not easy, but we did the best we could.

We discovered while dating that we shared a love of seeing Broadway Musicals together and in the past 10 years invested heavily in this art form. Which is why I referred to her as "My Happy Beautiful Broadway Musical and Theater loving Lovely wife of 30 years. We were fortunate to see the "Hamilton" musical locally on stage twice.

Vicki graduated from Bloomington Jefferson High School where she was active in theater. She graduated from Concordia College in Morehead Mn. and later received a Masters of Adult Education degree. Vicki was always

concerned about those who needed help. Her teaching work involved classes for new citizens.

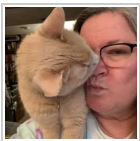
