Victor graduated from Vocational High School in 1953. After high school he was employed at Honeywell until he was drafted into the Army for two years; he reenlisted for an additional two years and was stationed in France. He was discharged in 1962. His employment at Honeywell was continued again after his time in the Army. While working at Honeywell he met Violet Anderson and they married in 1967. He was in the Army National Guard from 1979 until 1995. He retired from Honeywell in the same year. Victor received an Appreciation Award for his years of service to the Armed Forces from President Bill Clinton. In Victor's younger years he enjoyed going to the Unity Settlement House where he enjoyed playing basketball and ping pong. He excelled in ping pong and won many trophies. In his years after retirement he was very active in his Mormon Church visiting homes, was a Scout Leader for the Boy Scouts and was thought very highly of by his parishioners. Victor was also active in a program that delivered food to 43 households. He was a very loving and special person to everyone and especially to his family. Victor is preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Nicolas Morales, Matias Morales, Antonio Morales Jr; four sisters, Mary (Ernest) Rivera, Narcissa Lessard, Matha (Thomas) Lessard, Conception Morales and his wife Violet Morales.
