



Vietta Yolanda Glasper

May 23, 1927 - October 5, 2020

Vietta Yolanda Combs Glasper was born on May 23, 1927 in St. Joseph, Missouri. She was one of eight children born to lone Vietta Mitchell Combs and Ralph Theodore Combs. Vietta attended Bartlett High School and then graduated nursing school in St. Joseph. In 1948 Vietta married William (Bill) Daniel Webster and together Bill and Vietta had two sons – Stephen and William. Vietta worked as a nurse for many years and continued her nursing career until she married John Rudolph Glasper on August 6, 1963. Shortly after they were married, Rudy's military career took the family overseas to Japan, where they lived from 1964 until 1967 and again from 1970 to 1972. They also spent time in Thailand while overseas.

Vietta and Rudy and their two boys returned to the states for good in the late 1970s, living in Houston, Texas. Will and Steve left Texas in the late 80s to head north to Minnesota. Rudy and Vietta remained in Texas until 1998, when they joined their sons and their families in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Vietta and Rudy were married until Rudy's death on July 14, 2012.

Vietta is preceded in death by her husband John Rudolph Glasper; sisters, Juawana Elliot, Nevell Campbell, Mozette Noell and Theresa Thornton; brothers, Rafial Combs and Ramone Combs.

Vietta is survived by her sister Elise Hughes; sons, William Glasper and

Stephen Glasper; grandchildren, William, Symone, Roderick, Taushia, Ellen, Katie; great grandchildren, Neeva, Zoie, Arielle, DeWayne, Aaliyah and Robert; and many nieces and nephews and great-great grandchildren.

Vietta was an avid bowler and loved games of all kinds. She was a whiz at puzzles and would amaze you with her yo-yoing skills. She had a fondness for Asian art and sculpture and made the world's best sweet potatoes. Vietta was feisty and sweet woman who loved her sons more than anything.

She will be missed by many.

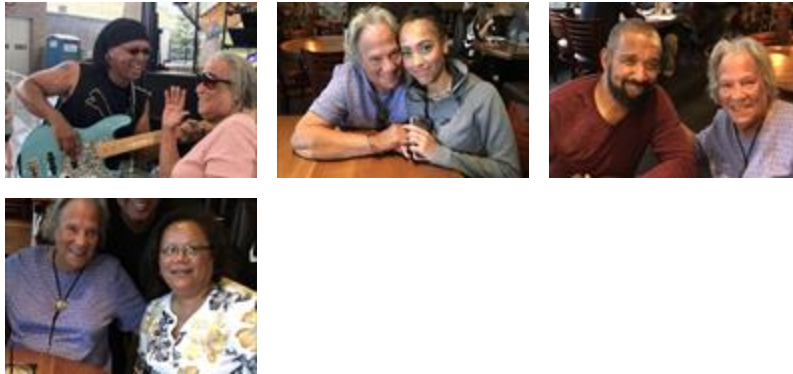
