Walter(Butch) wants to be remembered as an engineer, builder, and provider. He focused on organizing, making and perfecting things and processes. As an electrical engineer from the University of Virginia he made controls for tools for most of his career and automated his sailboat to enable him to continue sailing well into the 27 years that he battled Parkinson's disease.

A couple of friends introduced Butch to Ann Broderick. They were married in June 1965 and had two sons, Walter IV and James of whom he was very proud. Both Butch and Ann were born and raised in Washington DC. During their 58 years of marriage they lived in Silver Spring, MD; Greensboro, NC; Red Wing, MN; Forrest City, AR; Charlotte, NC; New Bern, NC; Cary, NC and St Paul, MN.

The family liked to travel. It might be a station wagon trip across the midwest to get a windmill tower for elevating the ham radio antennas. Some trips included Ann and Butch traveling, dining and seeing new places all around the world. Many trips involved cruise ships, Butch especially liked the water and he loved being able to provide trips for his family. For over 20 years there was an annual family trip to the beach in North Carolina.
